The Shelter encourages and works with all guests toward finding work and permanent housing as the primary route out of homelessness. The Shelter is a support and referral center for those who have serious health or mental health issues. The Shelter receives absolutely no federal or state tax dollars. The Shelter relies upon the generosity of individuals, churches, local businesses and fundraisers to fund the ministry. You are encouraged to visit the Shelter to learn more about BES.

DESCRIPTION The bikers will assemble at Green Mountain Harley-Davidson starting at 8:30 am or registration and a continental breakfast. Kickstands up at 10:30 am, then an enjoyable, scenic ride north to St. Albans, cruising through the hills of Vermont towards the Smugglers' Notch region then returning to GMHD for a delightful time of food catered by the Lost Nations Smoke Co. and fellowship. Ride will be approximately three hours in length with several stops along the way. There is a donation of \$35 for riders and \$20 for passengers and includes a BBQ dinner and T-Shirt.
